# Trans-Florida Central Railroad Trail

Florida

*Overview The Trans-Florida Central Railroad Trail is a 2-mile hiking and biking trail that sits along a former railroad corridor*



Sebastian.

The entire trail is flat, with the only incline along the trail found as the trail approaches the I-95 overpass. Additionally, most of the route is far from road traffic and noise, giving the trail a peaceful and secluded feel.

## Overview

The Trans-Florida Central Railroad Trail is a 2-mile hiking and biking trail that sits along a former railroad corridor that once connected Sebastian and Fellsmere. The centerpiece of the trail is the iconic bridge over Interstate 95: a broad walkway with two arches, meant to invoke images of the railroad bridges of a bygone era. The name of the trail is displayed prominently in huge letters across the span of the bridge.

## About the Route

Riders and hikers can travel on the paved off-road trail between the Fellsmere Preserve Trailhead, across I-95, and the North Indian River County Regional Park in

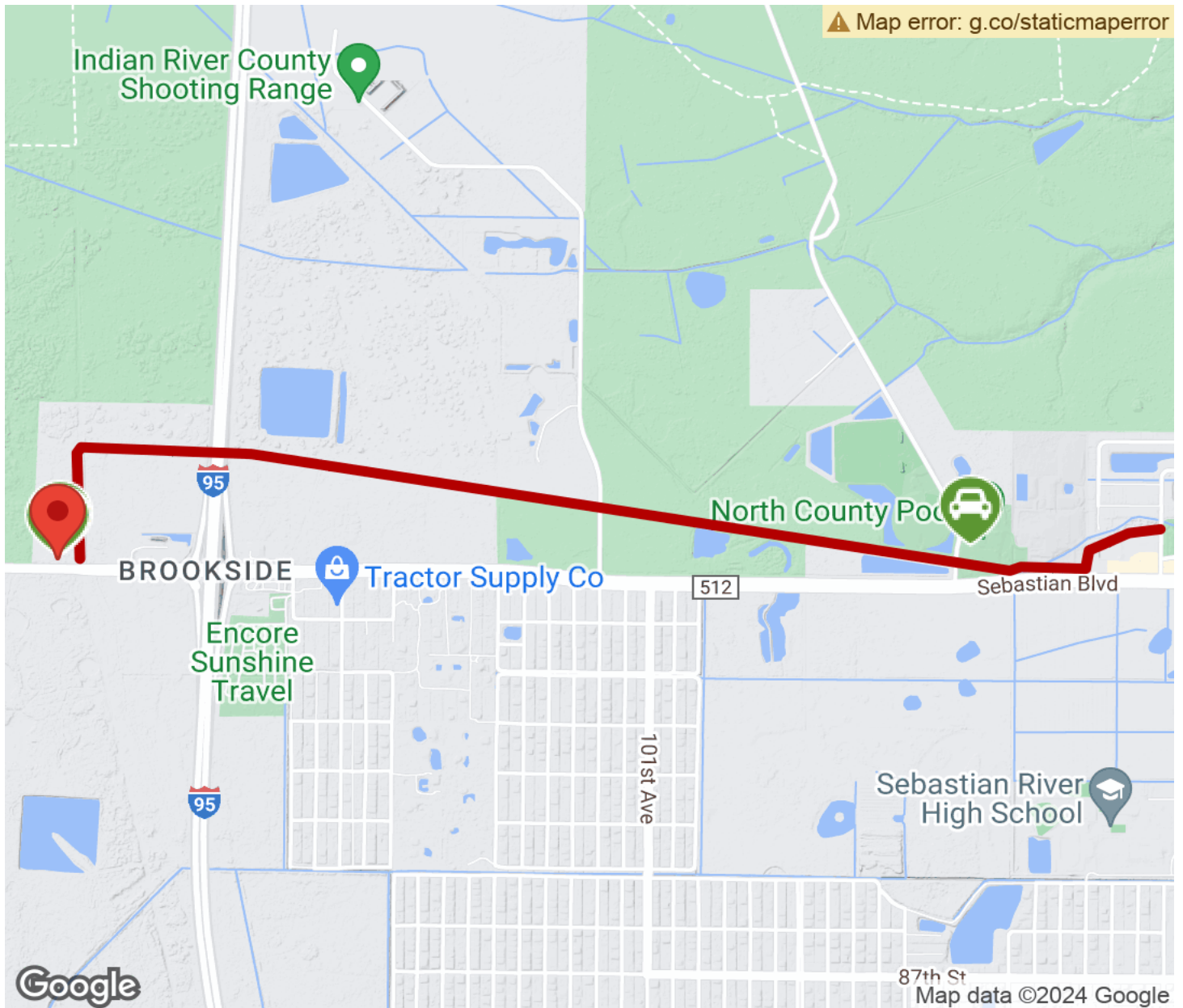
