Battery Bikeway New York



The Battery Bikeway is a only a half a mile long but it is an important link in the Manhattan Waterfront Greenway system,



The Battery Bikeway is a only a half a mile long but it is an important link in the Manhattan Waterfront Greenway system, connecting the East River Greenway with the Hudson River Greenway to form a 32-mile circuit around Manhattan island. The two-lane terracotta bike path begins at the end of the East River Greenway near the Governor's Island Ferry terminal and continues through The Battery and past many of its monuments and attractions. It joins the Hudson River Greenway at Battery Pl. and West St, and that trail in turn stretches another 13 miles north.
