In the city of Glenwood Springs on the banks of the Colorado River, three trails converge. To the east is Glenwood Canyon Recreation



In the city of Glenwood Springs on the banks of the Colorado River, three trails converge. To the east is [Glenwood Canyon Recreation Trail](#), to the south the [Rio Grande Trail](#) and to the west, is this relatively short multiuse path along Midland Avenue.

The Midland Avenue Trail is paved and extends east for 2.7 miles from the Rio Grande Trail up to Linden Street. A bridge offers views of the mighty Colorado River. The trail also offers access to some big box retail along the way.
