A community pathway that runs throughout the Castlegate subdivision on the southern edge of College Station, the Castlegate Trail provides a pleasant and convenient recreation asset for the residents of this suburban-style neighborhood. The northern part of the trail follows a nice tree-lined corridor that runs behind a row of houses, looping through the neighborhood and around a small pond before heading into Castlegate Park. The small neighborhood park features tennis courts and a playground, making it a popular destination for local families.

From the park, the trail splits into two branches: one branch heads northwest to Carlisle Court, while the other heads west along Castlegate Drive to Victoria Avenue. Taken all together, the Castlegate Trail offers around two

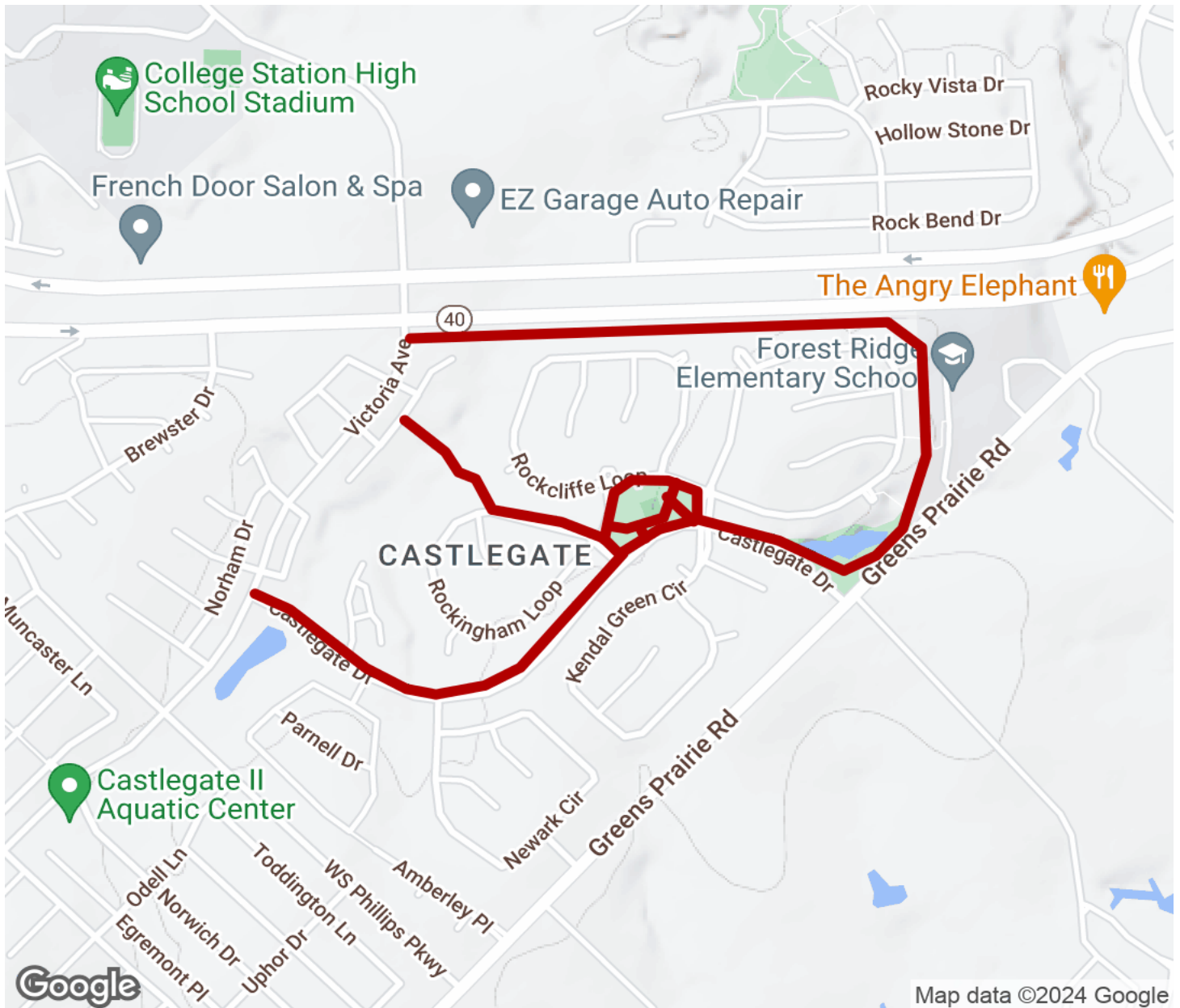
