Blue Lake is just south of the trail, which has a crushed gravel surface suitable for walking and biking. As you follow the trail through the wetlands, you may encounter a variety of wildlife. Access the western end of the trail from Main Street and the eastern end from Shore Access Road, where you can enjoy views of the Mississippi River.

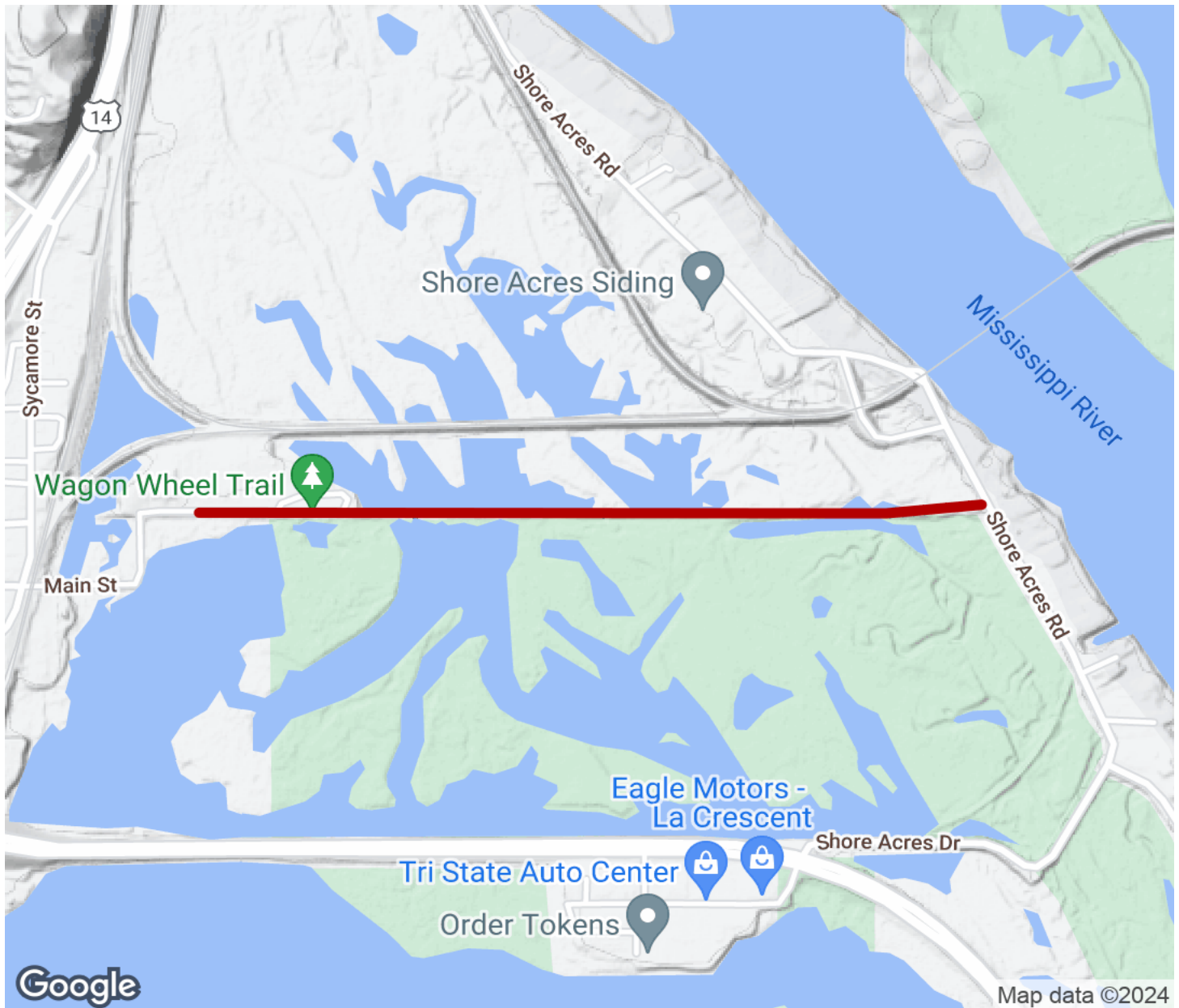
