*The Fort Hill Bike Path trail sits on the north side of Peterson Road/ County Road 20. The trail peels away from the Prairie Crossing*



The Fort Hill Bike Path trail sits on the north side of Peterson Road/ County Road 20. The trail peels away from the [Prairie Crossing Bike Path](#) at Midlothian Road and extends west, passing industries and farmlands, before ending just east of Behm Homestead Park. The trail is a hard-surface, 8-foot wide path that is accessible to a range of users. It offers almost 5-miles of travel out-and-back and users can extend their trip even further by continuing on the Prairie Crossing Bike Path, which in turn connects to the 30-mile [Millennium Trail](#). Lake County boasts over 550 miles of trails and bike paths.

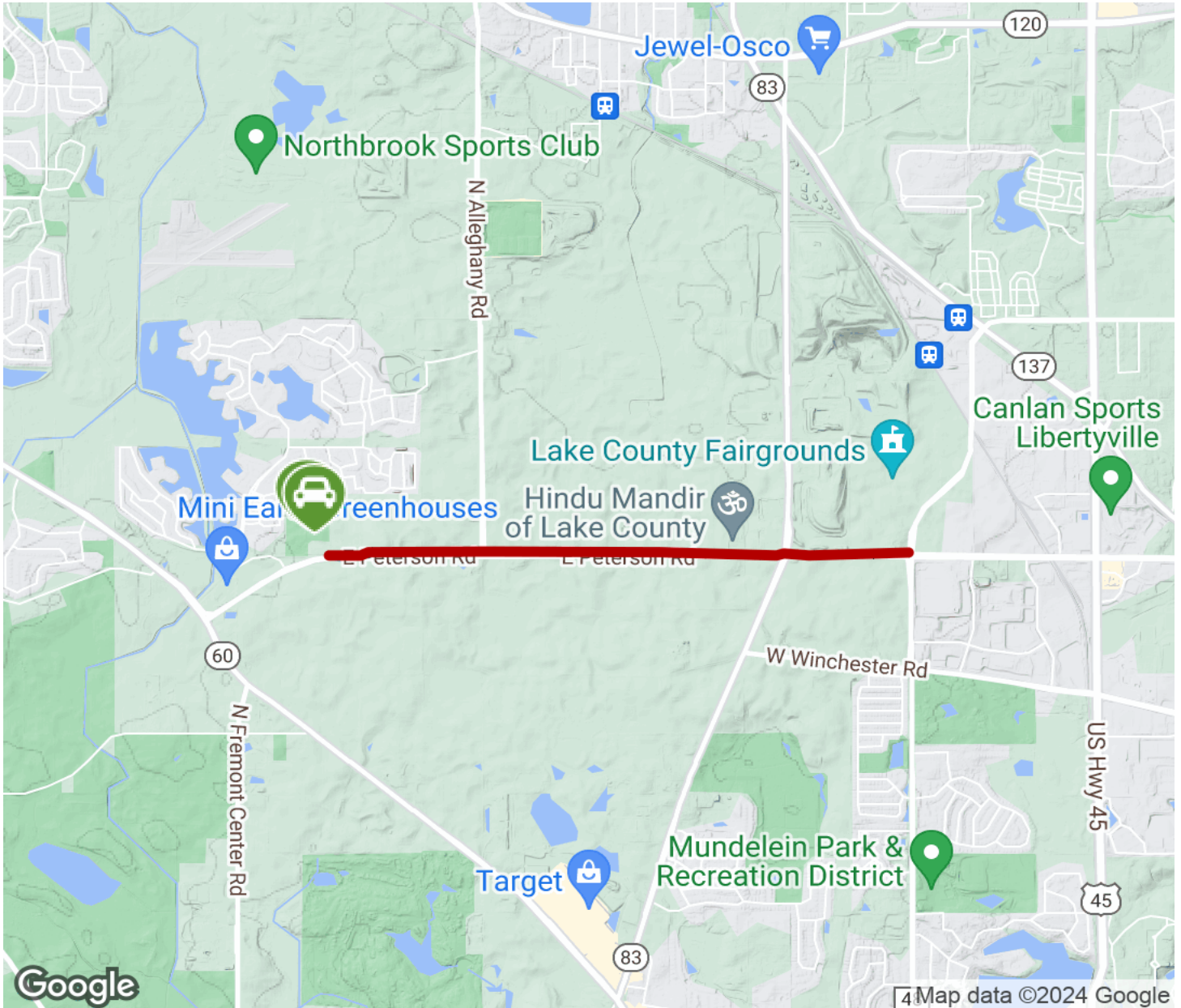
## Parking & Trail Access
