The Hugh Ward Boulevard Bike Path forms a convenient connection between the [Wirtz Road Bike Path](#) and the [Spillway Road Multi-Use Trail](#), helping to form a surprisingly extensive network of trails for cyclists and pedestrians in the Rankin County communities of Flowood and Brandon. The trail, a wide concrete sidepath, runs along the roadside past suburban housing developments, helping area residents access the popular destinations along the shores of the Pelahatchie Bay.

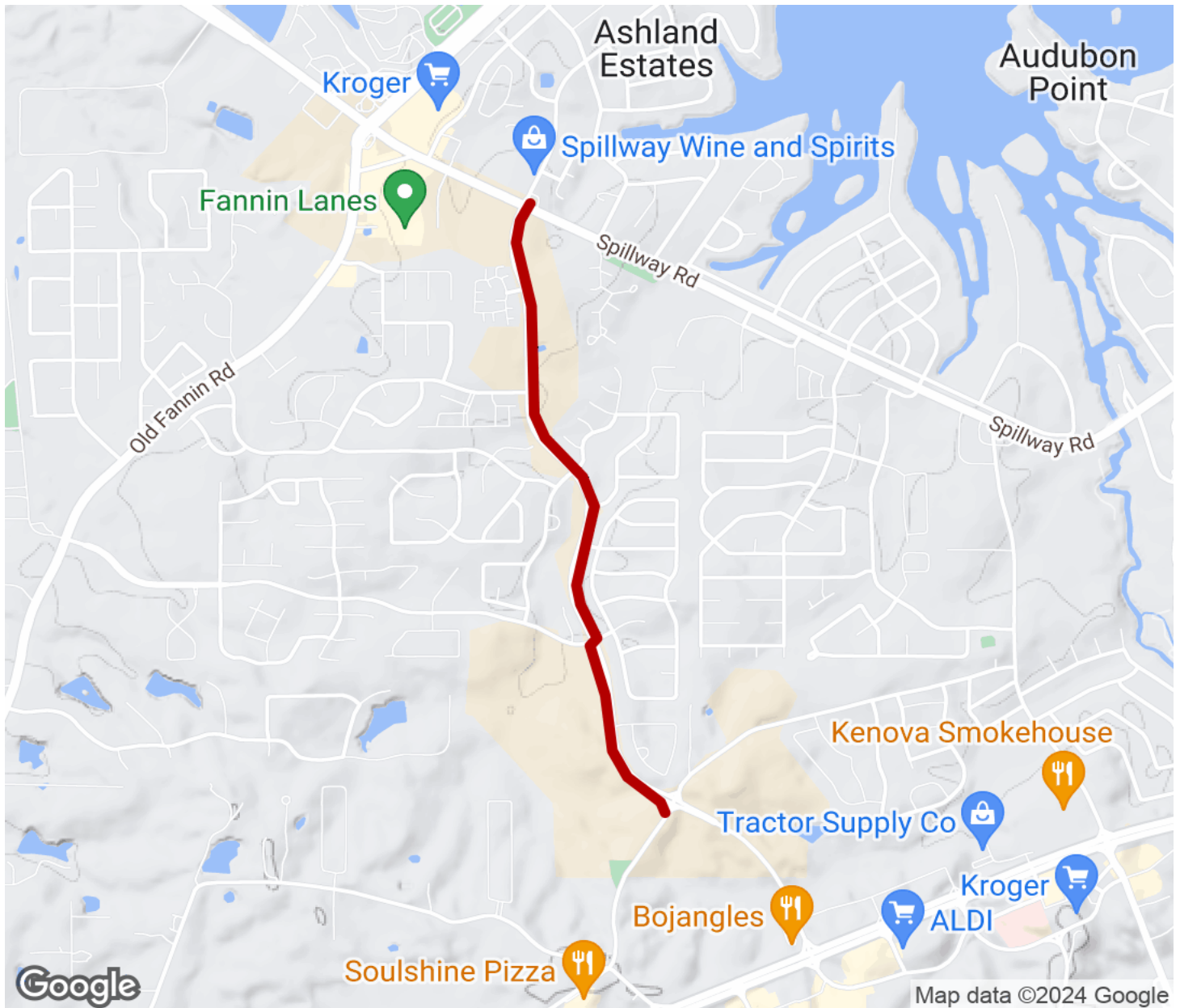
Parking & Trail Access
