County Highway PP Linear Parkway

Wisconsin

The CTH PP Linear Parkway Trail runs approximately 2.7 miles between Highland Avenue in the Village of Kohler East to 17th Ave.



The CTH PP Linear Parkway Trail runs approximately 2.7 miles between Highland Avenue in the Village of Kohler East to 17th Ave. in Sheboygan. A road diet project that reduced 4 lanes of automobile traffic to 2 lanes also allowed for the creation of this linear parkway.

The new John Michael Kohler Arts Center Art Preserve is one of the most prominent destinations along this trail. Three nature parks are also adjacent to the trail. Two are owned and maintained by Sheboygan County (Esslingen Park & Roy Sebald Sheboygan River Natural Area) and one is owned and maintained by Glacial Lakes Conservancy (Willow Creek Preserve).

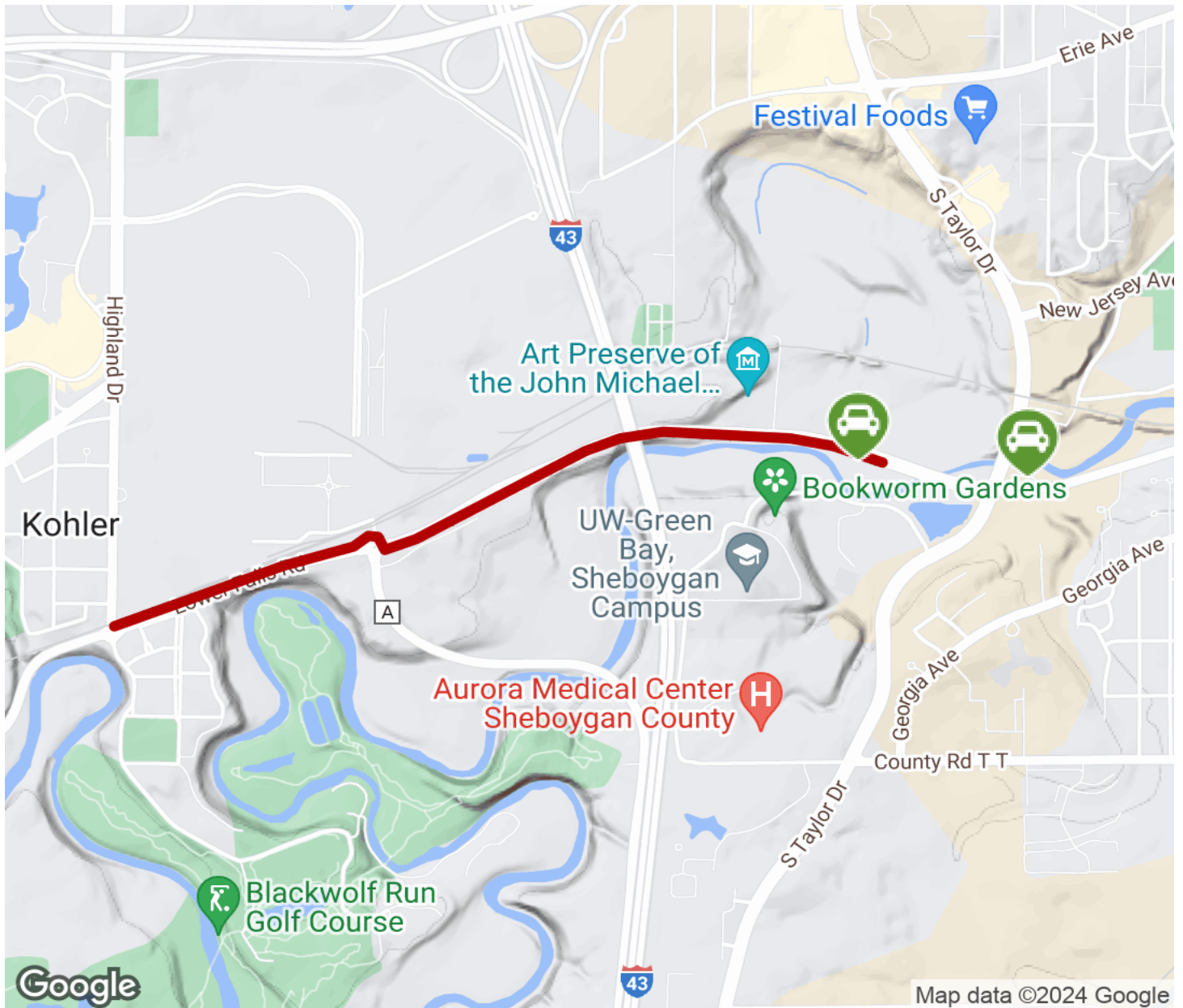
