Deer Creek Greenway

Missouri

This trail extends from Lorraine Davis Park in Webster Groves through Barnickel Park and Deer Creek Park to Deer Creek



This trail extends from Lorraine Davis Park in Webster Groves through Barnickel Park and Deer Creek Park to Deer Creek Shopping Center at Big Bend Avenue in Maplewood. Most of the trail is separated from the road except for two sections on relatively quiet streets – Pacific Avenue has a sidewalk and shared bicycle lanes, and Marshall Avenue under the railroad has a sidewalk.

At the north end of Lorraine Davis Park you can see the confluence of Deer and Shady Creeks. The pump track at the Marshall Avenue Trailhead has a pump track that is great fun for kids. Deer Creek Park, often called Rocket Park, has a space theme with a huge rocket ship.

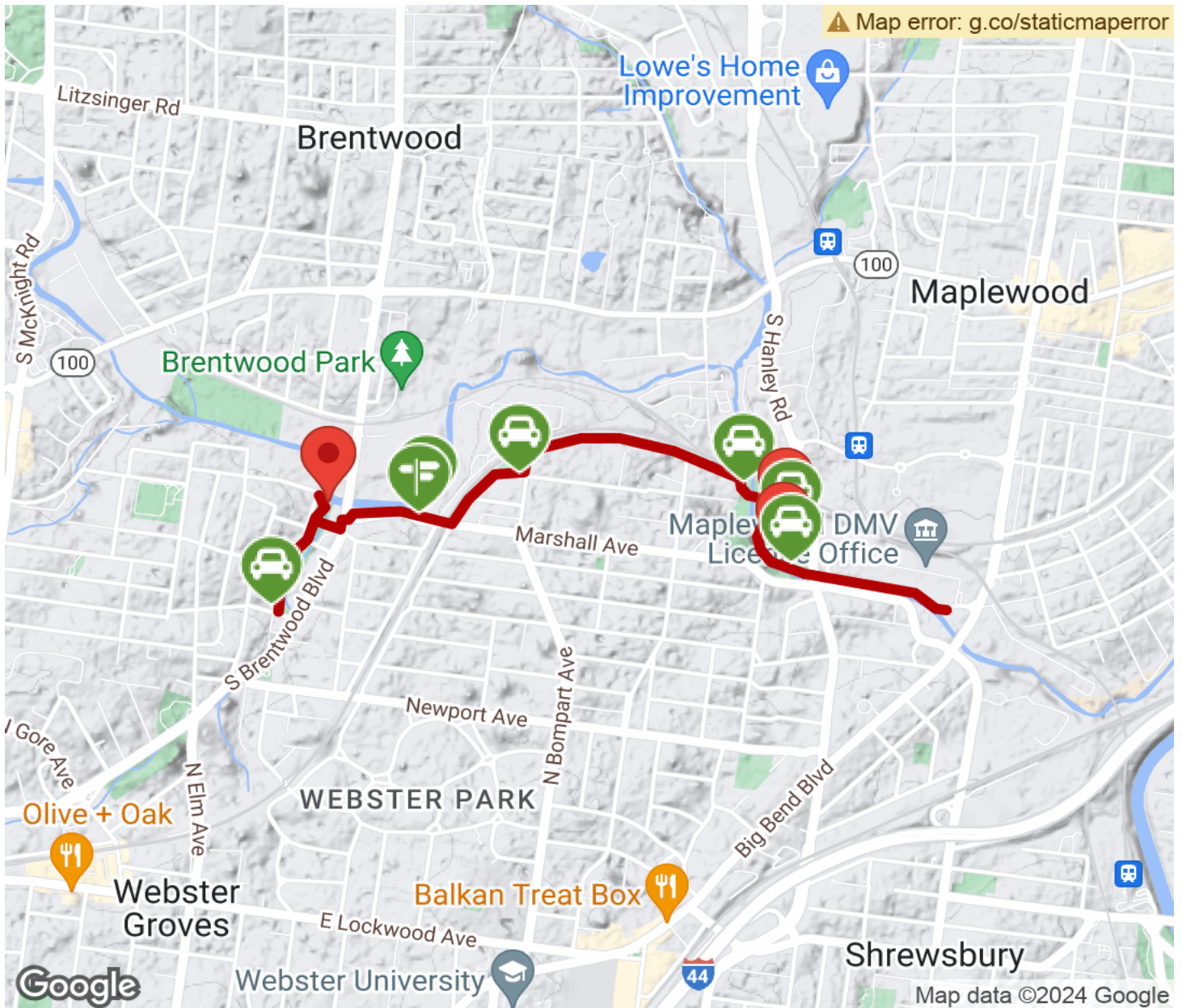
Parking & Trail Access

Parking is available in Lorraine Davis Park (700 Lorraine Davis Ln, Webster Groves, MO), at the Marshall Avenue Trailhead east of Brentwood Blvd (345 Marshall Ave., Webster Groves, MO), in Deer Creek Park (3200 N Laclede Station Rd, Maplewood, MO), and at the Deer Creek Shopping Center (3200 Laclede Station Rd, Maplewood).
