The picturesque Foundation Trail encircles the city of Black River Falls Wisconsin. It is a paved asphalt 10-ft wide trail that features

The picturesque Foundation Trail encircles the city of Black River Falls Wisconsin. It is a paved asphalt 10-ft wide trail that features bridges, benches, picnic tables and lights. It meanders around town following Black River and Town Creek.

It passes by a number of notable town attractions including the golf course, Lunda Community Park, the high school, fairgrounds and more.

Most of the trail is off-road, but there are two short sections that share the road. Where the trail ends at the Black River Area Chamber of Commerce, trail users can take S Water St. south until the trail starts up again a quarter-of-a-mile later. Where the trail ends at N 11th Street, trail users can continue south on N 11th Street,

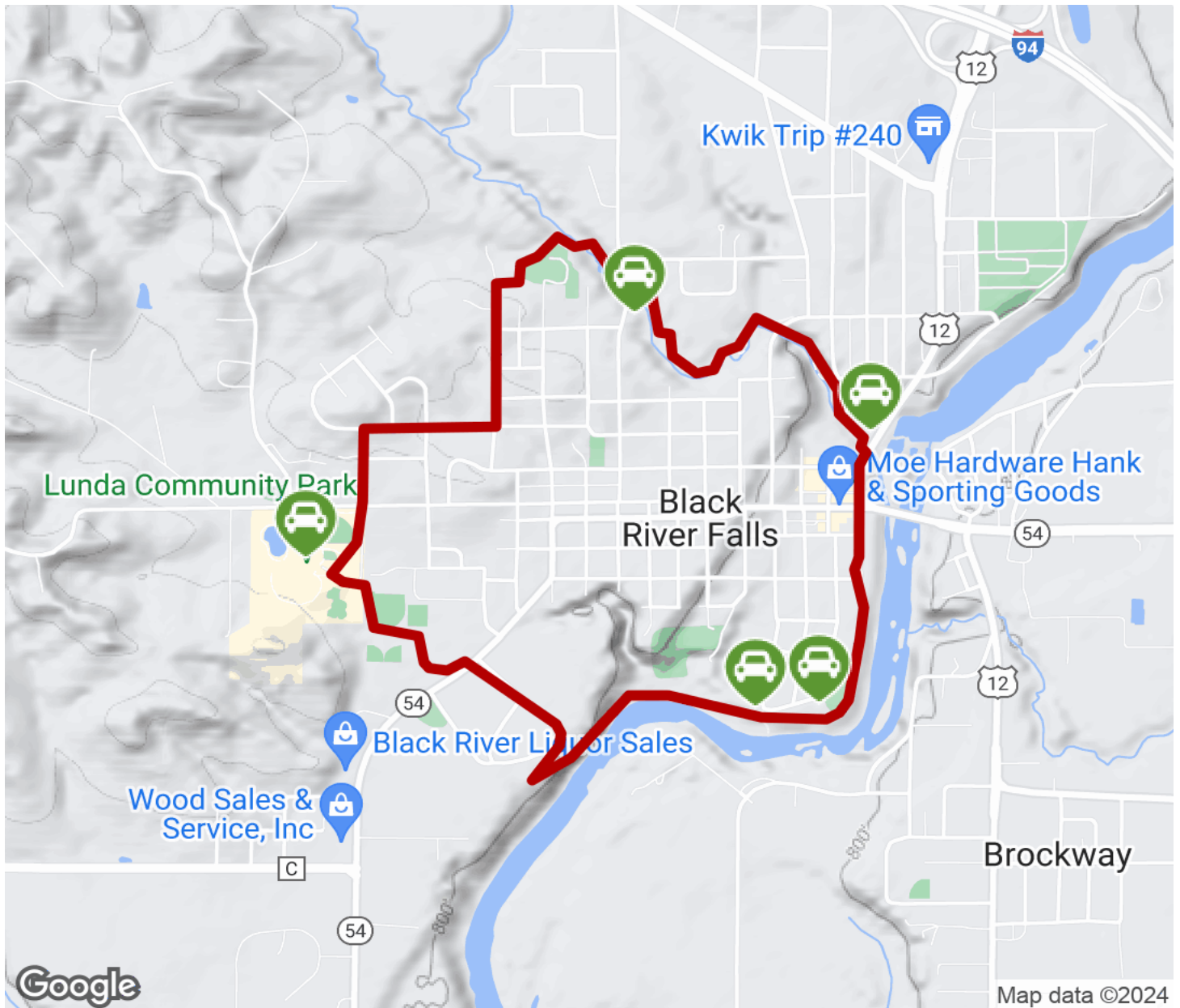
Parking & Trail Access
