The Erie Rail Trail takes trail users through the town of Huntington, linking Huntington University, Yeoman Park, and across the Little



South of Little River, the trail passes an active rail line and across the Little River. The current southern endpoint of the trail is just past Little River.

The Erie Rail Trail takes trail users through the town of Huntington, linking Huntington University, Yeoman Park, and across the Little River through town. It will one day stretch south of Huntington to the 4-H fairgrounds.

Constructed by HARTA (Huntington Area Recreational Trails Association) in 2015, the Erie Rail Trail follows the old Erie Rail Bed.

Starting from the trail's northern endpoint, the Erie Rail Trail travels south along a wide asphalt path nestled in between Huntington University and the university's cross country course. The first half of the route, follows a wooded path before reaching Yeoman Park. Yeoman Park offers a playground, baseball diamond, restrooms and playground equipment.

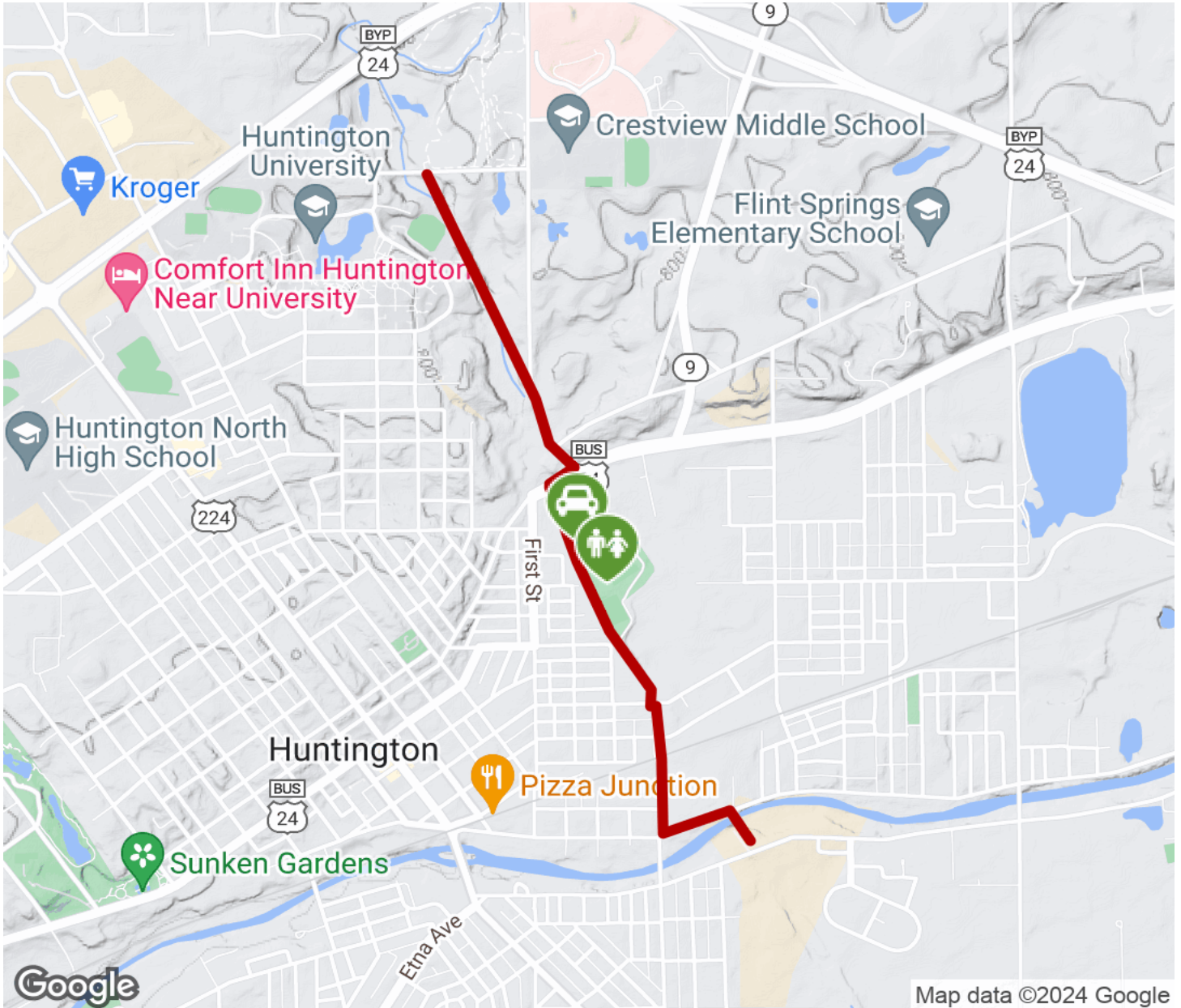
Yeoman Park, along 2nd St., offers parking for trail users.
