From here, you can bike or hike about 2 to 3 miles before reaching the wilderness boundary (hiking only). At the north end, you can access the trail from Wild River Road.

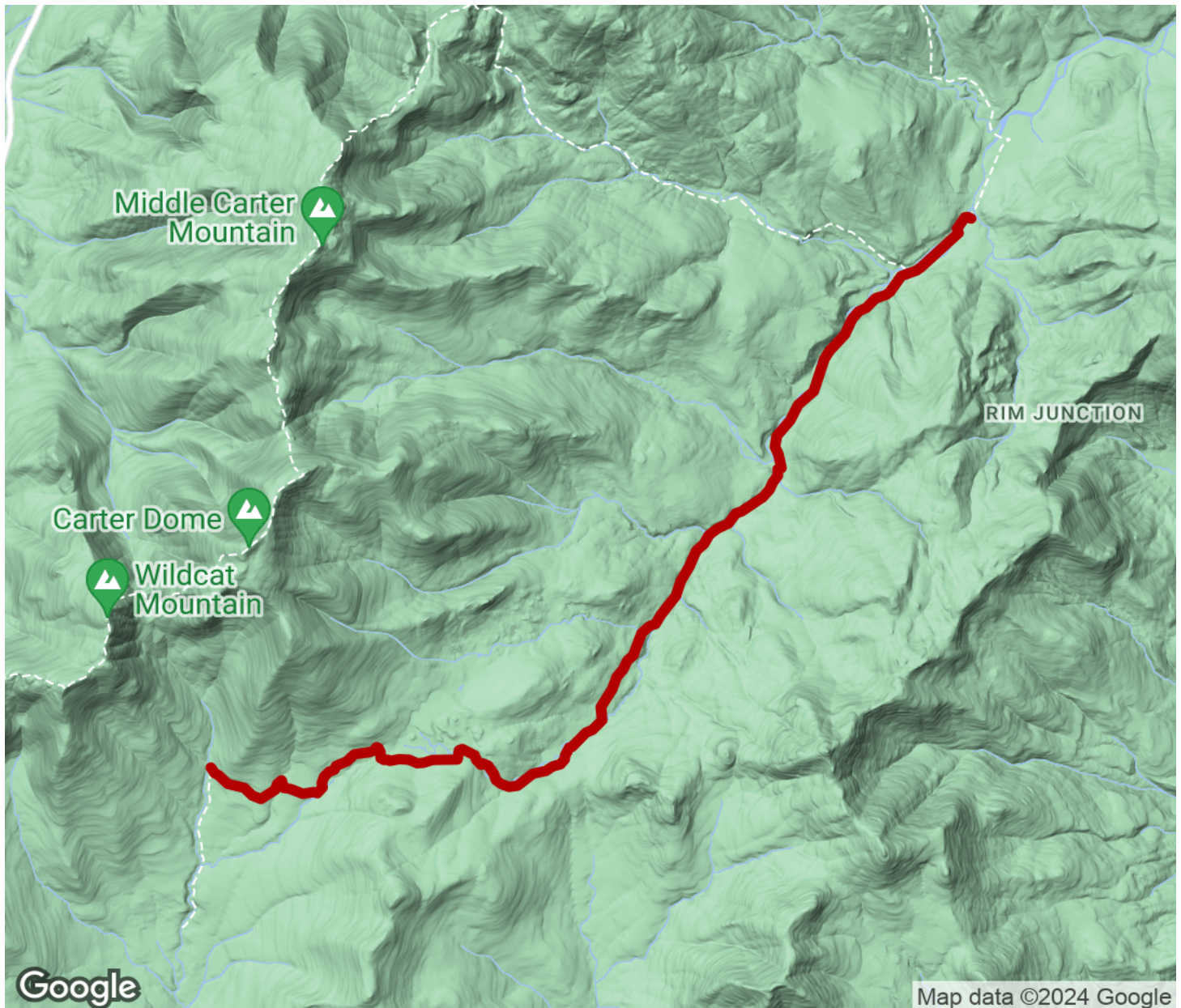
