

West Ashley Greenway South Carolina

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A favorite of local bikers and joggers, the West Ashley Greenway takes you on an 8.2-mile trip from Albemarle Road, near the Ashley River, through suburban Charleston to the scenic Low Country wetlands that surround this charming city. Nearly halfway through the greenway, you can connect to the 2.7-mile West Ashley Bikeway via a short on-road connection. Note that there are no restrooms along either trail, so plan accordingly.

About the Route

The West Ashley Greenway leaves off from its eastern trail end of the Charleston neighborhood of West Ashley at Albemarle Road and Croghan Spur Road, where trail users can find a historical marker for the Atlantic Coast Line Railroad's Croghan's Branch, which once served as



the eastern end of the main line from Savannah to Charleston. The partially paved greenway continues west through the former rail corridor.

From Wappoo Road, you could also continue west on the West Ashley Greenway. In 1.3 miles, at Parkdale Drive, the trail switches to a compacted gravel surface, then travels 2.3 miles to Croghan Landing Drive. The final 1.4-mile section, from Croghan Landing Drive to the western terminus at McLeod Mill Road, features a causeway along marsh and creek—a popular spot for crabbing, fishing, and wildlife viewing. Broad wetlands flanking the trail present magnificent views and rewarding coastal bird sightings. If your timing is right, trail users may be able to catch sight of the tidal flow that carved these lacework channels.

Connections

The West Ashley Greenway connects to the nearby <u>West</u> Ashley Bikeway.

The West Ashley Greenway is part of the East Coast Greenway, a vast and developing trail network from Maine to Florida.

The West Ashley Greenway runs between Albemarle Rd. (Charleston) and 3484 State Rd S-10-1377 (Charleston), which offers parking.


