Limited parking on Fireman's Memorial Drive in Mount Ivy. Parking is also available on Station Road in Pomona near the American Legion Hall.

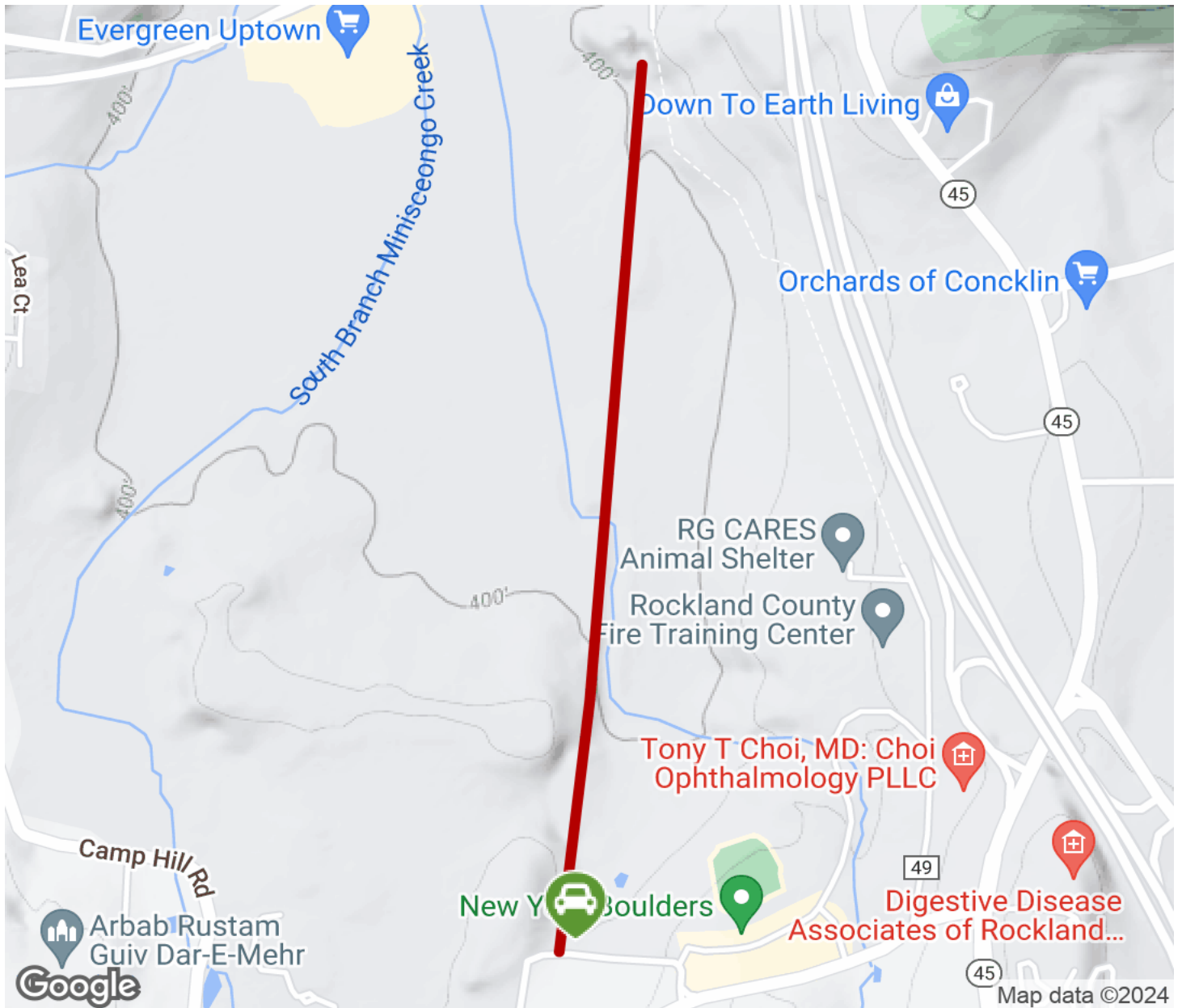
