Starting from Riverfront Park in downtown Fort Smith, where the annual Fort smith Riverfront Blues Festival is held, the Greg Smith River Trail traverses north from the town of Fort Smith and rolls along the Arkansas River and the border to Oklahoma.

The trail here transitions from a semi-urban environment to a woodsy and tranquil setting as it leaves Fort Smith. Along it's path, the trail passes John Bell Jr. Park (and playground), the Canoe Park and Sandy Cove Kayak Spot and Fort Smith Park where the trail reaches its northeastern terminus.

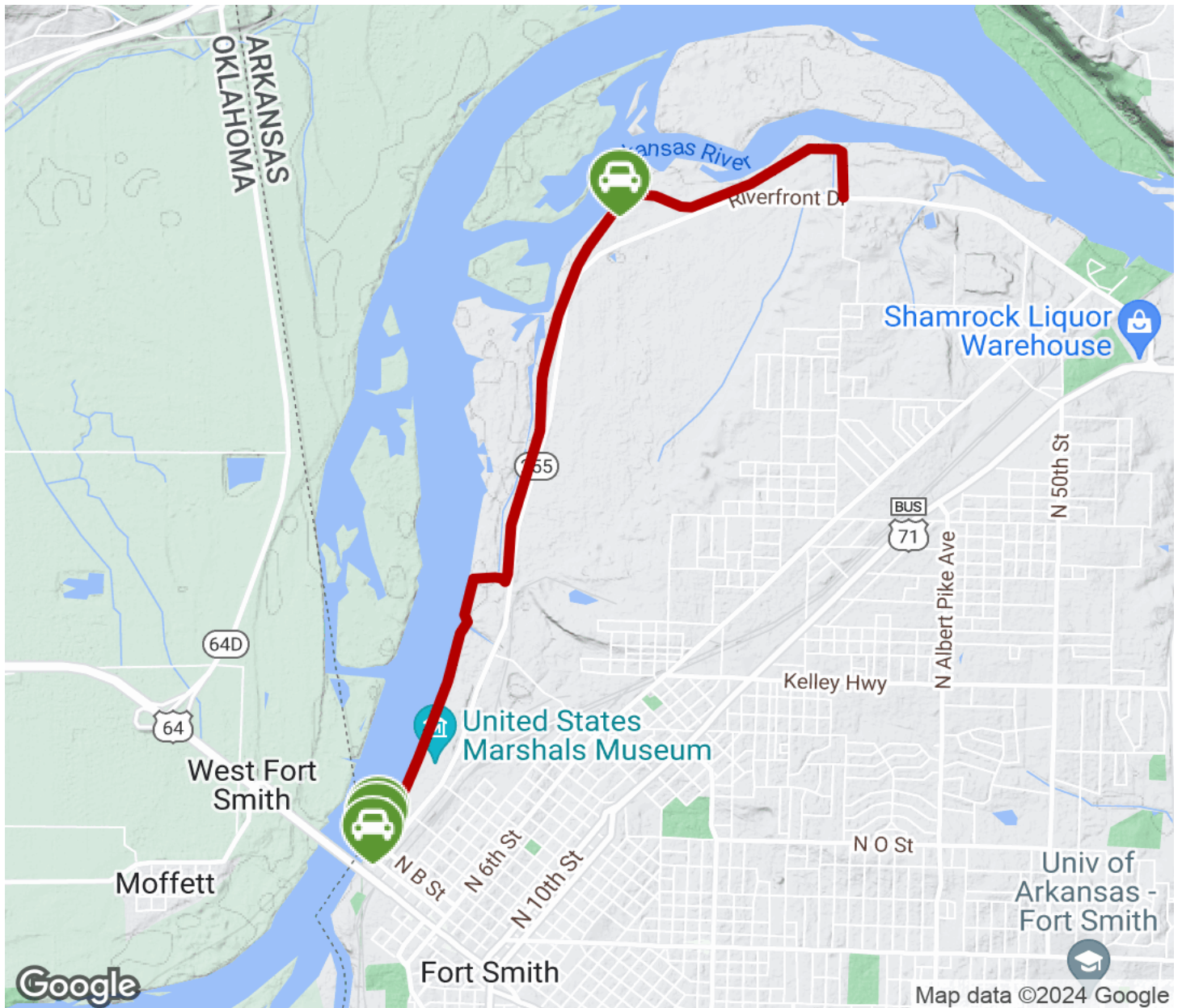
