Upper Coos Recreational Trail

New Hampshire



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The wildly scenic Upper Coos Recreational Trail parallels the Connecticut River, which divides New Hampshire and Vermont. The rail-trail begins in Colebrook and travels north to Beecher Falls near the Canadian border.

As the railroad tracks are still in place, you'll need to use caution. The unpaved trail is best used for hiking and horseback riding in the warmer months. In the winter, the trail is popular for snowmobiling, cross-county skiing, and mushing.

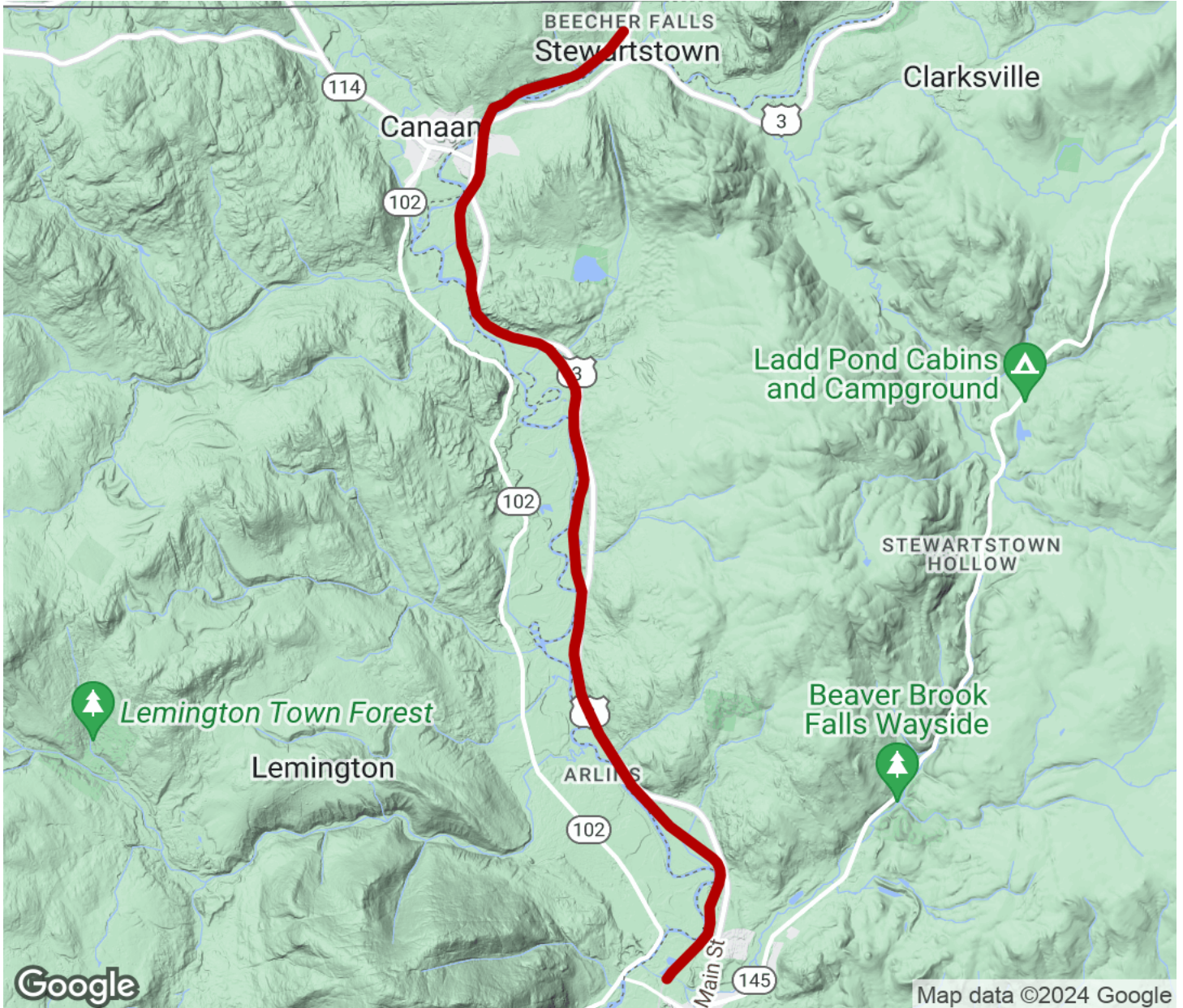
Parking & Trail Access
