Although less than 2 miles long, the Hagan-Burke Trail provides valuable connections to three other trails in the city of Carmel: the [Monon Trail](#) (an 18-mile RTC Hall-of-Famer that stretches to Indianapolis), the [146th Street Trail](#) that travels east-west through town, and the [Greyhound Trail](#). The paved trail, named after two community leaders, Judy Hagan and Ed Burke, winds through wooded areas along Cool Creek.
