The Presque Isle Bicycle and Pedestrian Walkway follows the course of the former Canadian Pacific Railway through its charming namesake town. The paved trail parallels the river for a short distance in Bicentennial Park on the north end before cutting across to Chapman Street and continuing south.

At St. John Street, the walkway heads east to the Presque Isle campus of UM. From here it continues a short distance to the convention center. Along the trail you'll find picnic areas, ball fields, tennis courts and a playground.
