The Riverwalk Exploration Trail parallels the western shore of the Colorado River along the Nevada/Arizona border. It travels



The Riverwalk Exploration Trail parallels the western shore of the Colorado River along the Nevada/Arizona border. It travels through a desert habitat and connects a busy resort area at its southern end with the Pyramid Canyon Day Use Area at its northern end. The recreational area offers fishing platforms, a playground and spray pad, shaded picnic shelters and restrooms.

The paved trail is also part of a larger Colorado River Heritage park and trail network throughout Laughlin.

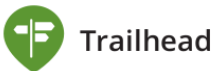
Parking & Trail Access
