The Great Valley Trail, built on the former Lehigh & New England Railroad, offers an unpaved, natural experience through quiet woodlands between the townships of Hampton and Frankford.

Although only 3.5 miles long, the rail-trail connects with two other rail-trails—the [Sussex Branch Trail](#) and the [Paulinskill Valley Trail](#)—for a continuous 13-mile loop.

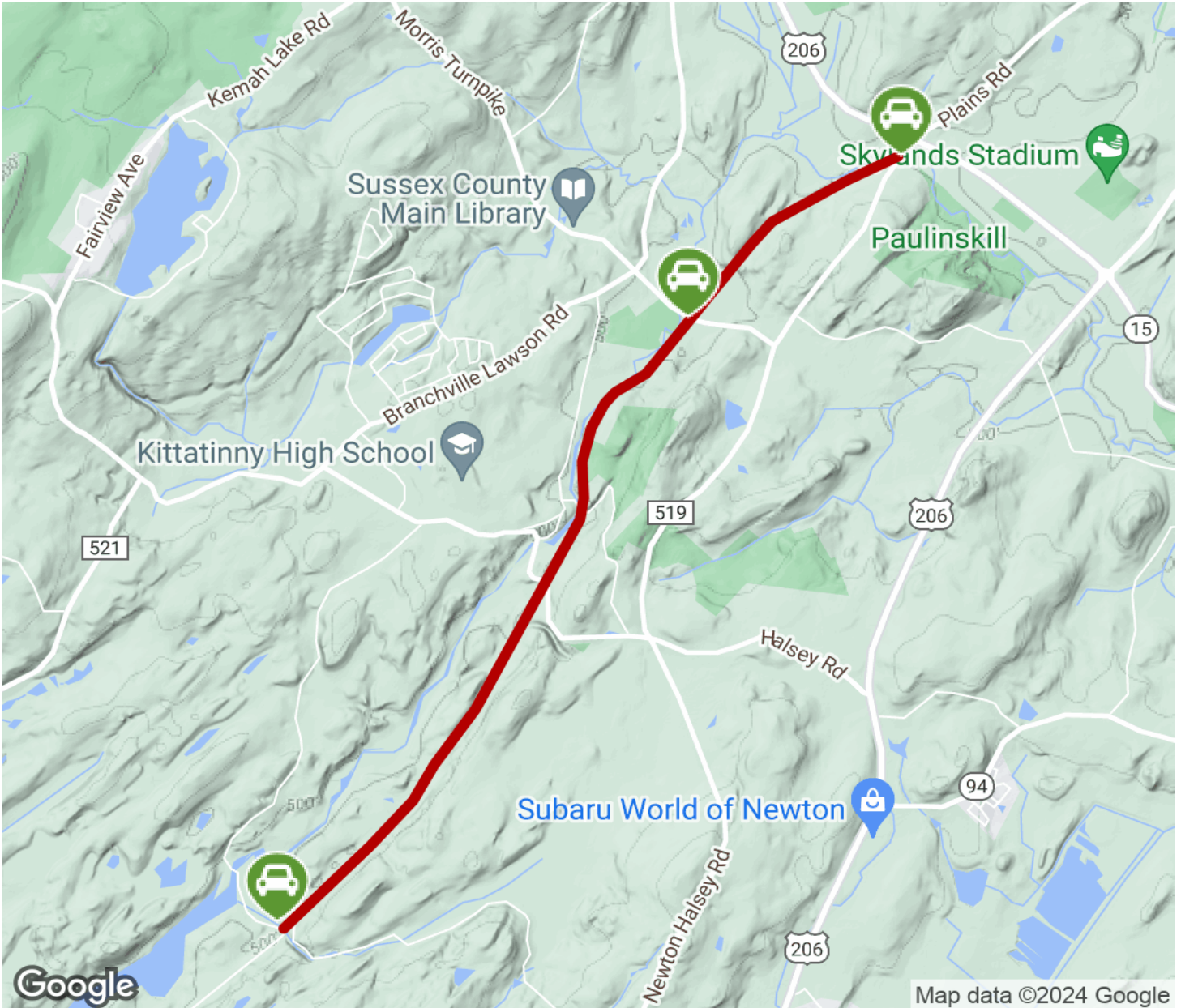
Parking & Trail Access
