The Foor Leisure Path is a short, paved trail that links the northern edge of Groveport's quaint residential core with the Blacklick Creek



The Foor Leisure Path is a short, paved trail that links the northern edge of Groveport's quaint residential core with the [Blacklick Creek Greenway Trail](#). The connection allows Groveport residents to travel seamlessly by bike or foot north to Reynoldsburg and west to Three Creeks Metro Park, and from there into Columbus via the [Alum Creek Greenway Trail](#).

Skirting the edge of a cornfield and pond, the Foor Leisure Path offers plenty of rural scenery in its nearly 1.5-mile length. Between the Elmont Place Subdivision and Bixby Road, the trail also runs through Cruiser Park, which offers several soccer fields.

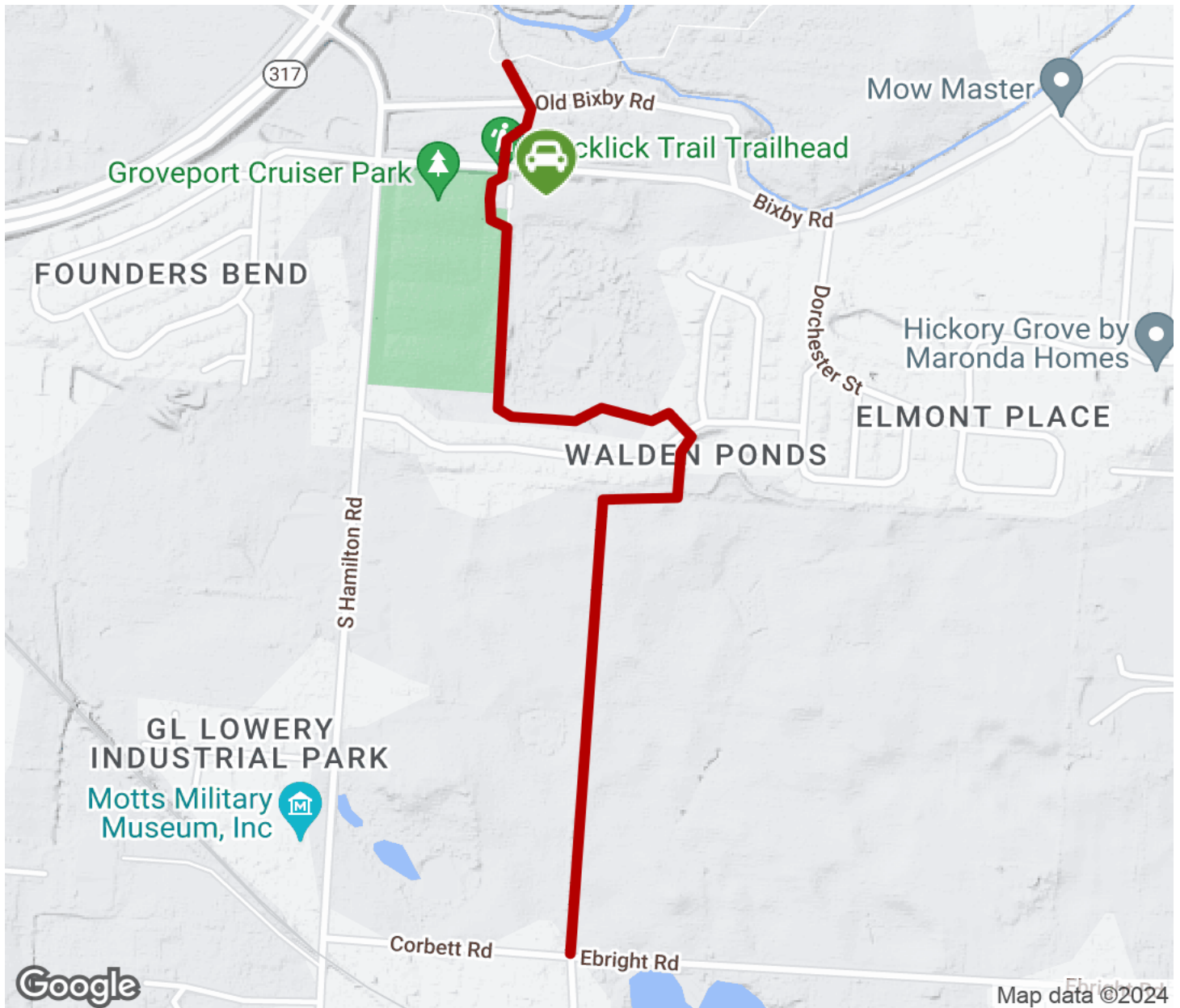
Parking & Trail Access
