Near the trail's midpoint, pick up the [Shady Canyon Trail](#) to head northeast to the scenic Quail Hill Preserve. Alternatively, continue on the sidewalk past University High School to reach the popular [University Trail](#) from the Bonita Canyon Trail's northern endpoint.

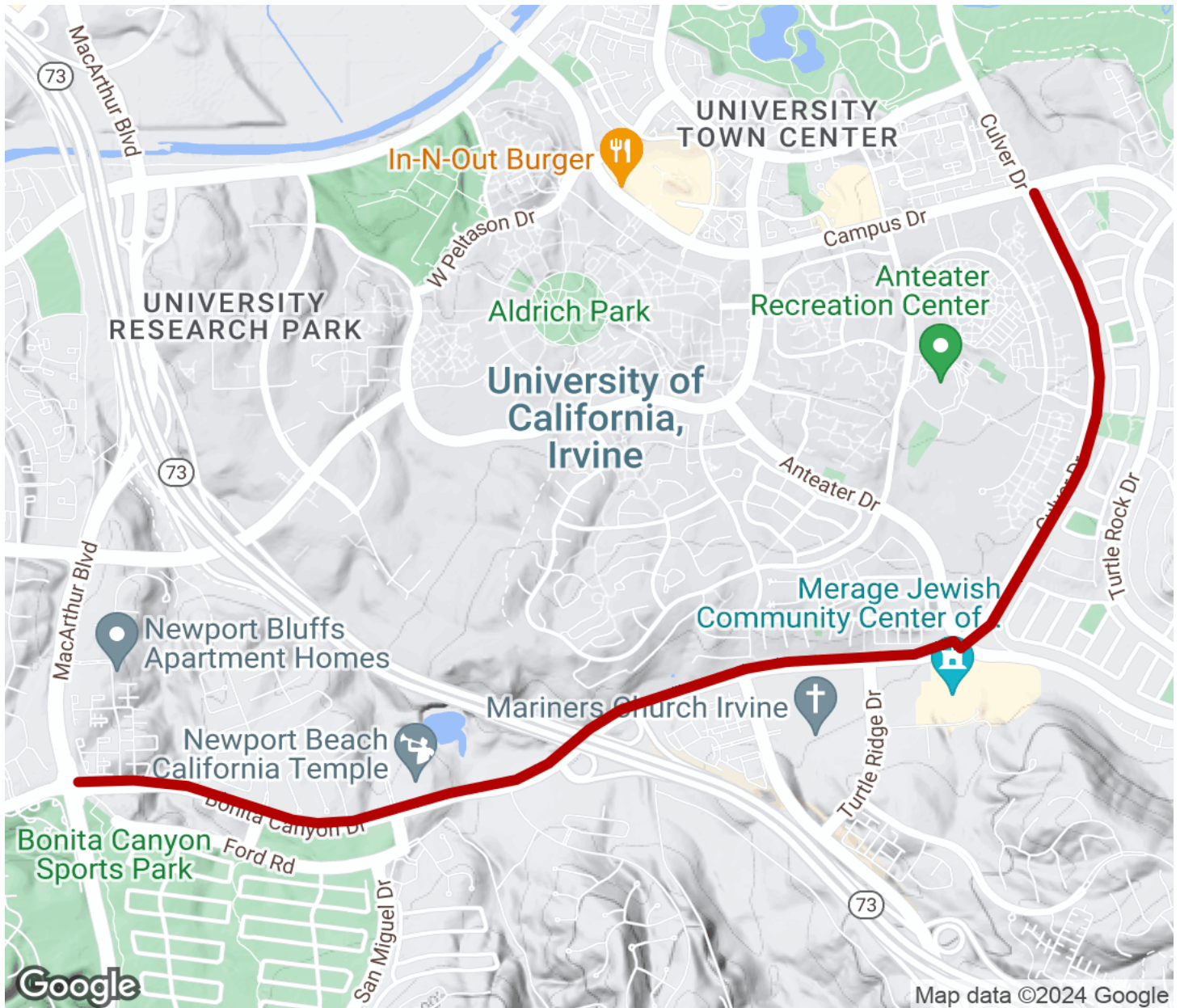
Parking & Trail Access
