The Austin to Manor Trail begins at a juncture with the Southern Walnut Creek Trail, then winds 2.5 miles through the northeastern



The Austin to Manor Trail begins at a juncture with the [Southern Walnut Creek Trail](#), then winds 2.5 miles through the northeastern outskirts of Austin. The paved pathway first parallels Daffan Lane through a rural area, then turns to loosely follow Decker Lane as it skirts through a more tree-filled area along the shoreline of Walter E. Long Lake.

The trail will one day total 5 miles when it's extended to the neighboring community of Manor (hence the trail's name) and end at Ben E. Fisher Park.

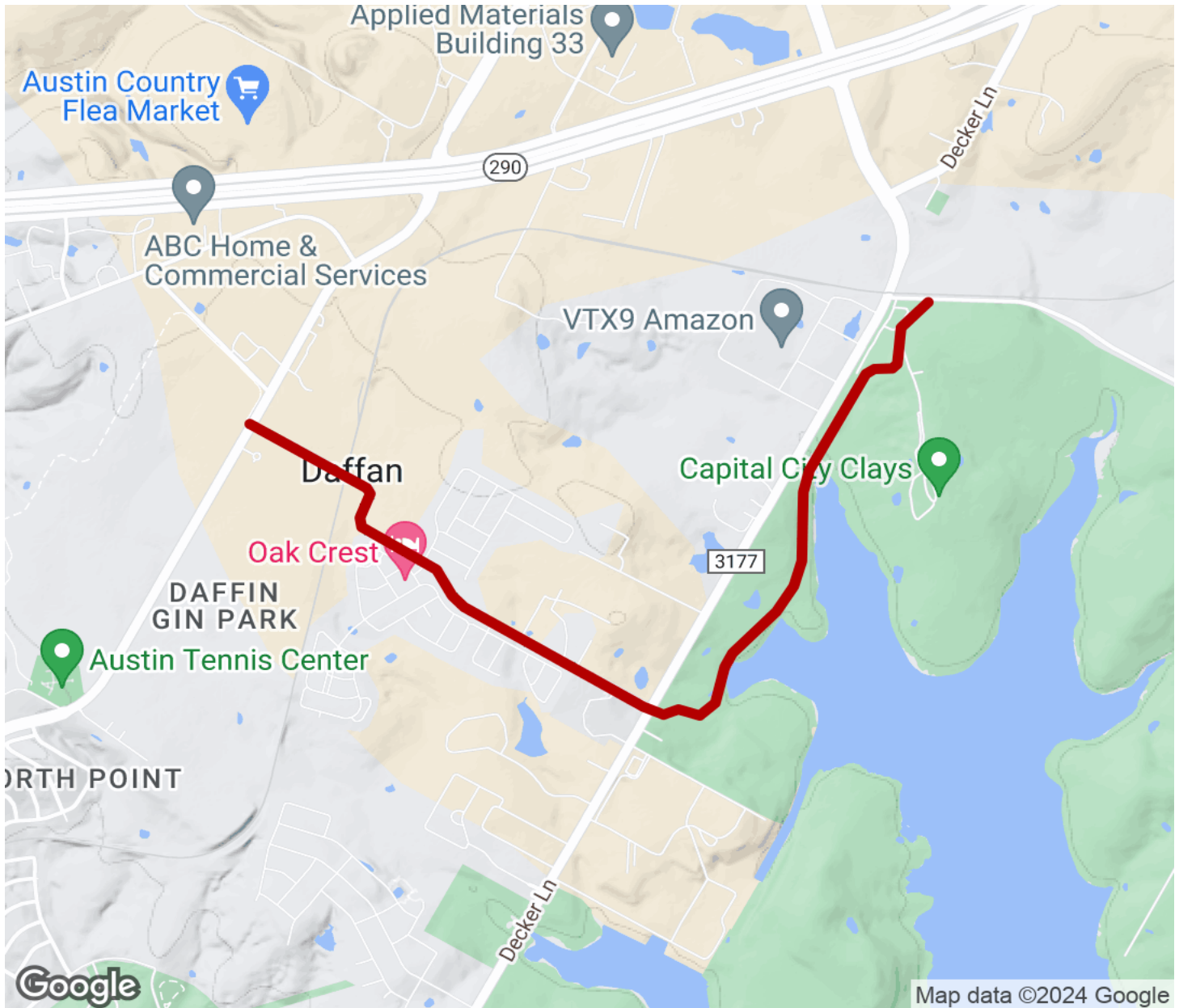
Parking & Trail Access
